VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT HOPE GOSPEL MISSION

BARGAIN CENTER

- **General Donation Processors** are needed to generate much needed revenue for our program and for our residents by sorting donations at the Bargain Center. By volunteering at the Bargain Center, volunteers give Hope Gospel Mission the opportunity to serve our residents using the funds created from the merchandise sold.

- **Bargain Center Greeters** are needed to welcome customers and guests to the Bargain Center. This position is important because the Store Greeter is the first contact a customer has with Hope Gospel Mission as they enter the store. The greeter would be responsible for answering basic questions about the Bargain Center as well as Hope Gospel Mission.

- An **Administrative Coordinator** is needed to answer phones, organize files, type letters, create spreadsheets, and handle other miscellaneous jobs at Hope Gospel Mission's Bargain Center.



This volunteer would work directly with the Bargain Center Manager to coordinate and help run an important business within the organization.

MEN'S SHELTER AND RUTH HOUSE

- **Meal Preparers** are needed to cook and serve nourishing meals and needed companionship to our residents. By cooking and serving meals, volunteers have the opportunity to provide an important, much needed meal to the poor and homeless, as well as friendship and hope for the future.

- **Shuttle Drivers** are needed to offer our residents a chance to build productive, meaningful lives, as well as earn money for the future, by transporting our residents to and from their jobs. We provide the vehicle and gas; we ask our volunteers to offer our residents their time, as well as hope for the future.

- **Office Volunteers** are needed to assist the receptionist and other office workers with important day-to-day work in order to effectively serve our residents. Office volunteers do everything from answer phones, to stuff envelopes, to accept donations brought into the mission. Office volunteers play an essential role within Hope Gospel Mission, and their services are extremely important to the residents of our program.

- A **Kitchen Manager** is needed to organize an extremely important part of our ministry--the kitchen and the food pantry. This volunteer would organize, plan, and coordinate meals with cooks so that our residents could be served as best as possible. Without a kitchen manager, an important part of our ministry is missing.

- A **Night Manager Assistant** is needed to give necessary companionship to our residents nightly. Night Manager Assistants have the opportunity to interact and affect our residents positively on a personal level. Night Manager Assistants give our residents hope for their futures through much needed companionship and guidance.
